Policy and Procedures Memorandum

To ensure that ULS students have access to High-Speed Internet technology and suitable living and learning environments, all new academic and residential facilities (as of this date) shall incorporate the latest Internet infrastructure technology and all new buildings shall be air-conditioned. Every effort shall be made to provide Internet access in every new classroom/class-laboratory, and every dormitory room as per established standards. The Assistant Vice President for Facilities Planning must approve exceptions to these requirements.

The High-Speed Internet technology, equipment and access shall be in accordance with the guidelines and specifications being developed by the Board of Regents' Ad Hoc Committee on Communications and Internet Technology and, as set forth in the STATE FACILITY PLANNING AND CONTROL DESIGN STANDARDS currently being developed.
